Man stabs 6 with butcher's knife on B'luru street, 1 dies

Bengaluru: Brandishing a butcher's knife that he had snatched from a mutton shop, a 30-year-old daily-wage labourer on Sunday killed one person and injured five others in a stabbing spree along a 2km stretch of central Bengaluru.

M Ganesh's 30-minute rampage through Anjanappa Garden, Chalavadi Palya and Bakshi Garden in Cottonpet ended after police overpowered him. Ganesh, a resident of Anjanappa Garden, told the cops he didn't know what he had done. He is suspected to be suffering from mental illness.

"Mari R, 30, also a daily-wage labourer, succumbed to knife injuries in hospital. Another person, Velayudham, is battling for life in a private hospital. The other four injured are out of danger," DCP (west) Sanjeev M Patil said.

The police have learned that Ganesh, who is estranged from his wife, would have frequent fights with his mother and others. "He was reportedly under treatment at Nimhans. We'll get his medical reports to know his mental

condition," a senior police officer said.

Ganesh was medically examined and his blood samples taken to check if he was under the influence of alcohol or drugs when he ran amok with a butcher's knife.

Ganesh, who lives with his mother, had left home saying he was heading out to buy mutton. Around 8.30am, he grabbed a knife from a meat shop near Balekai (banana) Mandi and started randomly targeting people.

"He had entered the shop as there was no space to stand outside because of road construction. He just grabbed the butcher's knife and fled," a police officer said, quoting witnesses. Victim Mari, who was standing near the shop, asked Ganesh to stop, at which the latter stabbed him in the stomach. When a few passers-by tried to catch him, the assailant took to his heels.

He went to Chalavadi Palya and then Bakshi Garden, where he attacked anyone who tried to stop him. The four men who escaped with minor injuries—Rajesh, Prakash, Suresh and Anand—are all local labourers working in the nearby vegetable markets.
